INTRODUCTION

This guide instructs you how to install the OPENworkshop and Dictionary-IV for Windows.

BEFORE INSTALLING THIS PRODUCT: Please refer to the latest Release Notes found on the product CD.

Package Contents

You should have received the following:

- At least one CD (check the version number).
- A Software License Agreement
- A Module code (located on the label)
- A Software Registration Card (please take the time to fill this out and return it)

Requirements

 Windows Server 2000/Windows XP/Windows Server 2003/Windows Vista/ Windows Server 2008/Windows 7

INSTALLATION

Backup Existing Program and Data File Before Installing

- Use site procedures to backup your application and data files.
- Use site procedures to backup the IPL, IPLINPUT, and TERMINAL files from the Thoroughbred Basic directory. From the IDL4 subdirectory, backup the TCONFIGW and TCONFIG8 files. The upgrade process will overwrite these system files, which describe how Thoroughbred products interact with your hardware and operating system.

Installed Directories and Files

NOTE: Starting with 8.7.0 the location of some OPENworkshop and Dictionary-IV for Windows directories and files have changed.

Windows Vista/Windows Server 2008/Windows 7

NOTE: The installations follow Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008, and Windows 7 best practice rules. Some of the rules enforced by Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008, and Windows 7 are: all executables must be installed in Program Files, files that require read/write access cannot be installed in Program Files or Window System folders. This requires a new directory structure.

- All executables are located in \Program Files\Tbsc.
- Files and folders shared by all users requiring read and write access are located in a common data directory \ProgramData\Thoroughbred Software\Tbsc. This includes IPLINPUT.TXT, TERMINAL, TCONFIG files, and the IDL4, UTILS, and WORK folders. TSI.ini and Tsiconst.ini are now located in \ProgramData\Thoroughbred Software.
- Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008, and Windows 7 will mirror files in \ProgramData\Thoroughbred Software\Tbsc and \Users\All Users\Thoroughbred Software.

Windows Server 2000/Windows XP/Windows Server 2003

- The default folder for all files including executables is C:\Program Files\Tbsc.
- Files previously written to C:\Windows are now written to the common data application folder. This folder varies depending upon the operating system. For Windows XP the folder is \Documents and Settings\All Users\Application Data\Thoroughbred Software.
- Thoroughbred Services previously installed in C:\Windows\System32 are now installed in the same folder as Basic; i.e. C:\Program Files\Tbsc.

Merge the Files

The merge will install various development modules: OPENworkshop, Dictionary-IV, VIP Host, Gateway for Windows, TS ChartServer, and TS ReportServer.

NOTE: TS ChartServer is not supported on Windows Vista, Windows Server 2008, or Windows 7.

The Basic Installation will copy the necessary files to your environment to perform the final step in the installation process. No media is required.

The merge process allows you to merge all products based on the module code provided with most media or to selectively merge products.

If you select the option to enter your module code, the appropriate products are automatically merged. This is the recommended method for merging products.

If you do a selective merge, a list of available products will be displayed. You will then be able to select a product or enter \mathbf{A} to install all products in the list. Care should be taken not to install any products that cannot be activated.

The merge process will prompt for the installation name and location of the directory for the installation.

From Basic Console mode, type **RUN "INSTALL"** to start the merge.

You can press the **Escape** key at any time to exit this procedure.

Object Library

By default, Thoroughbred products are placed in the IDOL-IV object library, which increases execution speed. You can unpack programs from the library or leave them alone. The Object Library Configuration screen will display the following message:

Press <F1> to remove programs from Object Library Press <CR> to continue Installation

Choose to SETUP or Exit

After you choose how to manage the object library, the following messages will be displayed:

Installation Completed! Press <CR> for SETUP Press <F4> to exit

To set up the OPENworkshop environment, press the **Enter** key. You will be placed in the Dictionary-IV System Administration window. For more information on how to set up the environment, please refer to the Dictionary-IV Administrator Guide.

You will be taken to the main OPENworkshop menu (OO).

Update Existing Records

As a convenience, a new Upgrade Administration menu has been added listing the items that must be updated after every upgrade.

Upgrade Administration

After the merge of an upgrade the Upgrade Administration menu is displayed. The upgrade can be done now or at another time.

From the OPENworkshop menu (OO) Select Utilities and then select System Administration to access the Upgrade Administration option.

From the Dictionary-IV menu, select System Administration to access the Upgrade Administration option.

Dictionary Update For more information on the Dictionary Update, see the Dictionary-IV Administrator Guide.

Generate Script Skeletons Recompile all of your existing scripts.

Compile Source Recompile all your existing source files

Compile Reports Recompile all of your existing reports.

Rebuild Sorts Rebuilds all Link Sorts.

Customize and Test

To customize your system, please refer to the Thoroughbred Basic Customization and Tuning Guide, and your product reference manuals, which will provide additional information on setting up your system.

Running OPENworkshop and Dictionary-IV

MESSAGES

The following messages are used in the installation program to indicate where the software is to be installed, inform you of any problems that may occur or inform you of procedures in progress.

Installation Program Messages

Exit? The Installation process has been aborted!

Press any key to exit. To properly run Dictionary-IV the installation program must be completed.

Exit? The Installation process is NOT complete!

Press **ESC** to exit or press any other key to continue the installation. If you exit, you must restart and complete the installation process to use Dictionary-IV.

Exit? The *X* Installation process is NOT complete!

(*X* refers to the version of Dictionary-IV you are installing). Press **ESC** to exit or any other key to continue the installation. If you exit, you must restart and complete the installation process to use Dictionary-IV.

Exit? *X* has not been properly installed!

Press any key to exit the installation. When you exit, you must restart and complete the installation process to use Dictionary-IV.

Installation Completed! All programs have been installed into an Object Library.

Press Enter for Setup or press F4 to quit. The installation process is complete. You must run the programs from the Object Library.

Installation Completed! The installation programs have been removed from the Object Library and saved into the directory!

Press Enter for Setup or press F4 to exit. The installation process is complete. You must run the programs from the individual directories.

NOTICE Before the products you have selected can be installed, Dictionary-IV or IDOL-IV must reside on the system.

Press any key to continue. Dictionary-IV must be properly installed before installing any other OPENworkshop product. Check to insure that Dictionary-IV is installed on your system. If this is your first installation, make sure Dictionary-IV is selected.

NOTICE The Dictionary "IDDBD" is now being expanded!

The System Dictionary is being expanded. The process may take from 5 to 15 minutes. When it is complete, the installation process will continue. See your Dictionary-IV Reference Manual for more information on the System Dictionary.

Object Library Configuration. All programs have been installed into an Object Library called "IDOL-IV."

Press **F1** to remove the programs from the Object Library. Press **Enter** to continue the installation. The programs will be executable only from Object Library.

Software Error! An Error *X* has occurred at Statement number *X*.

Press any key to exit the installation process. A software error occurred and installation is not complete. Note the error number and statement number then report it to the Thoroughbred Product Support Group. Dictionary-IV will not function properly until the error is corrected.

Thoroughbred Dictionary-IV Installation. Thoroughbred Dictionary-IV has not been installed or cannot be located.

Enter the directory number (or open the window and select the one) in which you wish to install this version and press **Enter**. Press **ESC** to exit the installation. If you exit the process, you must restart and complete the installation to use Dictionary-IV.

Thoroughbred *X* Installation. Thoroughbred Dictionary-IV exists in the directory named below.

Press Enter to continue the installation process. Press ESC to exit the installation.

WARNING! None of the IDOL-IV based product files can be located for installation.

Press any key to exit the installation and check to ensure the files have been properly loaded. You must restart and complete the installation to use Dictionary-IV.

WARNING! The Dictionary file "IDDBD" is busy and cannot be expanded!

Press any key to exit the installation. All users must logoff Dictionary-IV so the file may expand. Expansion takes from 5 to 15 minutes. When it is completed, you must restart and complete the installation to use Dictionary-IV.

WARNING! The file "IDOL-IV' is defined but is NOT an Object Library!

Press any key to exit. To properly install this version of Dictionary-IV you must either ERASE or RENAME this file. Once this has been done you must restart and complete the installation to use Dictionary-IV.

Windows not enabled.

Press any key to exit the installation. The installation of this product cannot proceed until you enable Windows. Once this has been done you must restart and complete the installation to use Dictionary-IV.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Troubleshooting Messages

ERROR 12 when trying to put your programs into an Object Library.

The INSTALL program may not have installed OPENworkshop.

Enter the **RUN ''INSTALL''** command from Thoroughbred Basic Console Mode.

ERROR 12 when trying to RUN "ID" from Thoroughbred Basic Console Mode.

The INSTALL program may not have installed OPENWORKSHOP.

Enter the **RUN ''INSTALL''** command from Thoroughbred Basic Console Mode. If this error recurs, free additional memory and try again.

Memory problems when allocating all leftover memory to EMS.

Reconfigure EMM386 to free 4MB. Enter the **RUN ''INSTALL''** command from Thoroughbred Basic Console Mode.

Unable to find Basic Utilities after installation.

The Object Library exists and you can use the **RUN ''ID''** command. However, /* and /** from any Dictionary-IV menu produces an invalid selection error.

You may not have had enough memory available when installing. Free additional memory and enter the **RUN ''INSTALL''** command from Thoroughbred Basic Console Mode.
